Redenhall with Harleston Town Council and the Harleston & District Branch of The Royal British Legion are delighted to announce a full parade through the town scheduled for this year on Sunday, November 12th. All participating groups, organizations, and individuals will assemble at the Market Place and Exchange Street at 10:30am.

The parade route will lead down the Thoroughfare, taking a right turn into Broad Street, where we will gather at the War Memorial for the wreath-laying ceremony and act of remembrance. This will be immediately followed by a Remembrance Day Service at St. John's Church.

During the September Town Council meeting, the council members reached a consensus for the Clerk to submit an application to the South Norfolk District Council for the 'Pride in Place' grant. This grant will fund a feasibility study which will evaluate two primary options: the potential renovation or expansion of the current building, and the construction of a new facility to replace the existing Memorial Leisure Centre at its current location.
