Town Council Updates

Flow plates at the Town Car Park (Co-Op)

We wanted to update and notify all residents that the flow plate in the Town Car Park (Co-Op) was removed on the 29th April by Norfolk County Council.

However, it is important to note that it remains illegal to enter the car park from Bullock Fair Close as it violates the Road Traffic Order.

There are 'no entry signs' at the top of Bullock Fair and violating these will result in £100 fine and 3 points on the offender's license. The police will monitor the situation based on the number of complaints received and will conduct periodic reviews.

If deemed necessary, SNDC will explore the possibility of engaging a private company to install an enforcement camera.

Community Building Feasibility Study Steering Group

We have formed a steering group to oversee the feasibility study for a community building in the town. Regular updates will be available at each Town Council meeting, and we will keep you informed through this newsletter and on our website as well.

Roof Repairs at the Leisure Centre

Roof repairs have been successful at the Leisure Centre and the scaffolding has been removed. We are now awaiting scaffolding to be placed at the Clock Tower so that the long-awaited survey can take place and any remedial work and cleaning can take place as soon as possible.



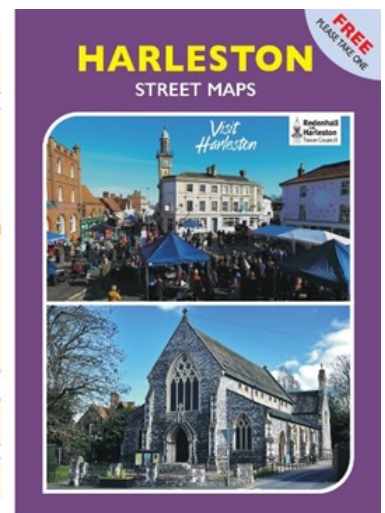
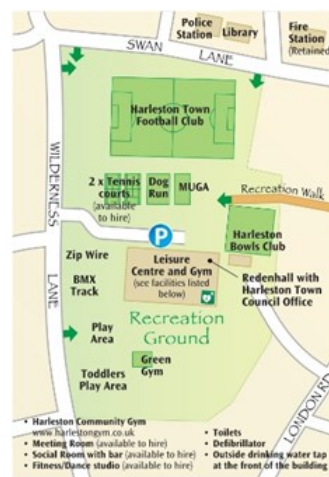
Harleston events!
